Our exceptionally popular **Young Gaiety** and **Youth Theatre Workshop** classes will resume on Saturdays in Temple Bar, Navan, Malahide and Bray, complimented by a series of masterclasses for the serious young actor. PAGE TO STAGE *

This 10 week course will expand on the skills and confidence developed in Introduction to Drama or a similar drama course. Participants receive an opportunity to employ the basics of drama through text - the next necessary step in drama training. Students will study script writing, text analysis and character development necessary to create effective performance.

Participants of Page to Stage can expect to:

- have the opportunity to approach and work with text creatively
- get training in how to approach text from a performance perspective
- experience rehearsal, with all of the repetition, emotional and physical exploration this involves
- rehearse with a scene partner an imperative performance training tool
- experience and evaluate the actor-director relationship

ACTING FOR CAMERA 2: Practical Skills *

Students will have already completed Acting for Camera 1 and will be introduced to the technical requirements of film as well as the basic analytical skills used to explore script.

Participants of Acting for Camera 2 can expect to learn:

- to critique your work
- to break a scene down into beats based on character want and need
- subtext: what it is and how it is communicated through behaviour
- scene shaping through rehearsal
- shots: what they are, the different sizes, and how to adjust the performance according to the size of the shot

- private preparation: what to do and what to avoid
- vocal requirements for film
- basic audition techniques and tips


CAREER TALK with Patrick Sutton

LESSAC KINESENSIC VOICE & BODY with Robin Carr



This 5 day workshop is specifically designed for those interested in experiencing stronger, more resonant vocal quality with ease, in conjunction with creating more physical flexibility, strength and expressive body movement. Lessac Kinesensic Training is unique in its holistic, comprehensive and creative approach to all aspects of developing the body and the voice, for speech and singing and as creative instruments of communication, behavior and perception. Kinesensic training is a self-teaching, sensory-based process based on feeling the way the human body functions naturally when it is free of adverse conditioning. It then uses those physical sensations to identify, produce and voluntarily control the voice and body. This training is beneficial for actors, singers, directors, barristers, presenters, businesspeople. A daily schedule would be full of instruction with appropriate breaks within that time frame.

Participants of Lessac Voice & Body can expect to learn:

- posture and breathing
- breath support and breath control
- body energy and flexibility
- body conditioning and physical fitness
- body characterization
- vocal variety and contrast
- text interpretation
- development of full dynamic pitch range
- control of projection for stage, microphone, and personal use in intimate, social, or formal situations
- development of the male and female voices for speech and singing
- connecting physical and vocal life to the emotional experiencing system

ROBIN CARR is an Associate Professor of Voice and Acting in the Department of Theatre at the University of Southern Mississippi. Ms. Carr is a Lessac Certified Trainer, one of only 53 in the world. She is currently President-Elect of the Lessac Training and Research Institute and a member of the Voice and Speech Trainers Association. Robin was fortunate enough to teach a workshop with Arthur Lessac himself at the University of Rijeka in Croatia and taught the Lessac Kinesensic voice and body work for their new Post Masters' Program under the direction of International Hollywood Star, Rade Serbedzija. Robin has also taught the Lessac work for the prestigious National Institute of Dramatic Art in Sydney, Australia and for the Theatre Actors Guild in Manila. Philippines.

Using the physical stretching and warm up 'buzzing' and other vocal practices we were put through will help sustain my voice in work presentations, my singing and any future work I may get involved in.

COMMEDIA DELL'ARTE INTENSIVE with Ronan Dempsey

This intensive 5 day workshop is designed for Actors, Directors and Writers. It will require a high performance commitment from all participants. Commedia Dell'Arte is the most magical territory in theatre where the passions of humankind are pushed to their limits. This workshop will explore all aspects of this style - the cruelty, the tragedy and the fear. Fear of life, fear of death...fear of all things. It will delve deep into extreme greed, hunger and love. It will look at what it is to survive and what humankind will do to achieve survival and status...e.g to persuade, to dupe, to take advantage, to trick, deceive, cajole, betray etc. It is hugely beneficial to artists interested in improvisation, comic writing and characterisation.

Participants of the Commedia Dell'Arte Intensive can expect to:

- learn the history of Commedia Dell'Arte and the importance of this style of theatre to today
- find the high level of play needed for Commedia Dell'Arte
- master the scale of the 7 primary emotions
- explore the 7 states of tension

- devise and improvise a Commedia Lazzi and an ensemble group piece in an end of week showcase


VOICE WORKSHOP

SINGING WORKSHOP

This course will give students a basic understanding of how the voice is produced and works through song. Similar to a fingerprint, each voice is unique. The day will be divided into two components with the morning focusing on supporting and controlling the voice through warm up exercises and routines and the afternoon focusing on performance through song. Students are asked to prepare one song (preferably a musical, folk song, or popular ballad) and to bring a print out of the lyrics with them. Students do not need to be able to read sheet music to participate in this course. As long as you can sing in the shower and bring buckets of enthusiasm with you, then this course is for you!

Participants of the Singing Workshop can expect to:

- learn how to support, control, develop and enhance their natural vocal ability through exercises that focus on breathing, support, voice resonance and placement
- learn how to tailor-make a warm up and exercise routine that will allow them to further develop and strengthen their natural abilities after the course.


THE CASTING CALL



VIEWPOINTS & SUZUKI for Actors:

The workshop will begin with an introduction to Suzuki training and will continue with explorations of the Viewpoints. Based on the traditions of Japanese Noh and Kabuki theatre, the Suzuki method is a rigorous training technique meant to strengthen the mind, body and voice through a series of precise and demanding exercises. Each exercise emphasizes rigor and stillness simultaneously to create dynamic and opposing forces in the body. Suzuki training awakens the warrior in every actor to create and harness power in performance.

- explore the 9 principals of the physical viewpoints (tempo, duration, repetition, kinesthetic awareness, shape, gesture, spatial relationship, architecture and topography)




MAKE A MOVIE adult


