ACTING FOR STAGE

INTRODUCTION TO DRAMA

This is the perfect course to get started in acting. Taught by skilled tutors with years of experience working in the theatre & film industry, the course is also a great fit for those wishing to build confidence or improve communication skills. This ten week course culminates in each person delivering a chosen monologue to their classmates.

ACTING FOR SCREEN

ACTING FOR CAMERA 1

Working with experienced and knowledgeable tutors you will learn the craft of acting for camera, concentrating on putting together the basic techniques required to deliver effective performances on screen.

This eight week course provides participants who have already learned core acting techniques an opportunity to explore the similarities and differences between stage and screen acting. The course focuses on the development of physical, vocal and emotional techniques required for film.

- Develop the ability to identify and deliver credible cinematic performances
- Foster the nuances of physical, emotional and intellectual elements necessary for screen acting
- Learn and practice the differences between stage and screen acting

ACTING FOR CAMERA 2

Students will have already completed Acting for Camera 1 and will be introduced to the technical requirements of film as well as the basic analytical skills used to explore script.

By working intensely on a film scene and monologue, students will develop an understanding of the nuances of delivering a convincing performance on screen.
