

A Game-based methodology for empowering Dementia friendly communities and equal access to Culture for people with Dementia (pwD)



The main priority of the project CURATE-D is to promote equal opportunities, accessibility and social Inclusion of people with Dementia (PwD) in cultural experiences. All the activities implemented and developed through CURATE-D project aim to train the people working in the cultural field on creating dementia friendly culture communities and to train professional carers of PwD to support PwD in cultural activities.

Therefore, the project will develop an innovative educational methodology based on games, addressed to people working in the cultural field and other professional caregivers to provide them with tools to enhance their skills to support people with dementia (PwD) in cultural experiences. CURATE-D is an Erasmus+ Project funded by the European Commission and coordinated by Challedu in Athens (Greece). The organisations also involved are: Panellinia Omospondia Nosou Alzheimer kai Sinafon Diatarachon Thessaloniki (Greece), The Gaiety School of Acting, The National Theatre School of Dublin (Ireland), Herakleidon Museum of Athens (Greece) and Asociación de Familiares de Enfermos de Alzhéimer de Valencia (Spain).





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Thus, through this two-year project, which started in January, the partners objectives are the promotion of social inclusion and equal accessibility to culture for people with dementia, the adaptation of education and training of professionals (VET) in the cultural field to the current needs of accessibility and inclusion, the development of an innovative educational methodology and a set of tools for education (VET).

As a result, the project will create a methodological guide, a learning training guide for the staff of cultural venues, a learning training guide for the professional carers to support PwD in cultural activities and an educational serious game. Also, the project will include a training of professionals and conclusions report. All these tools will be freely available for use by professionals in the cultural field on the project website.

These new tools will enable professionals in the cultural sector to create dementia-friendly cultural communities and to collaborate with professional caregivers of PwD to support them in cultural activities.

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
